In these uncertain and confusing time in our history, CASA of Polk County thanks you for assisting the work we do for foster children. As you know, Court Appointed Special Advocates provide support and guidance through the court system to make sure each foster child's basic rights and essential needs are being met.

Our goal is to provide a trained CASA volunteer for every child who is a ward of the court due to abuse or neglect. Before the start of the pandemic, 86% of foster children in Polk County had an assigned CASA for support. We want to continue to improve this level of care until 100% of all foster children in Polk County have a CASA. Research has demonstrated that children who have a CASA volunteer by their side are more likely to find a safe permanent home, succeed in school and, half as likely to re-enter the foster care system.

Given the current situation, the need for trained CASAs has increased and will continue to climb as life begins to return to the "new" normal. CASA of Polk County work remains more important than ever for our foster care children, especially in these unsure and rapidly changing times.

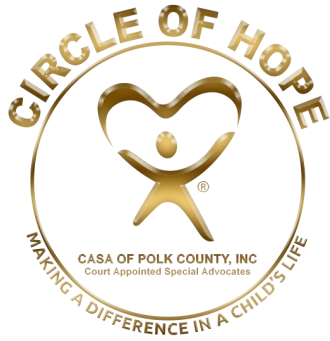

Your generous donation will provide support for the following

\$100 – Training manuals for four new CASA volunteers

- New CASA volunteers are required to undergo 30 hours of curriculum in class training, plus 10 additional hours of court room observation.
- We have 2 training classes every year. Each has a beginning average of 6 – 12 volunteers.

\$250 – Scholarships for CASA volunteers and staff to attend professional child welfare training's.

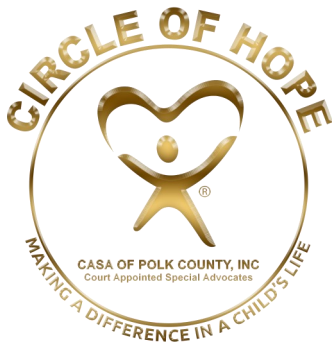
- CASA volunteers and staff are required to take 12 hours of additional continuing education hours per year to meet National CASA Association guidelines and requirements.

\$1,500 – Child advocacy cost per year per child

- Average length child is in care is two years.
- Polk County has roughly 150 cases on any given day.
- Currently, we advocate for approximately 86% of these cases.
