In these uncertain and confusing time in our history, CASA of Polk County thanks you for assisting the work we do for foster children. As you know, Court Appointed Special Advocates provide support and guidance through the court system to make sure each foster child's basic rights and essential needs are being met.

Our goal is to provide a trained CASA volunteer for every child who is a ward of the court due to abuse or neglect. Before the start of the pandemic, 86% of foster children in Polk County had an assigned CASA for support. We want to continue to improve this level of care until 100% of all foster children in Polk County have a CASA. Research has demonstrated that children who have a CASA volunteer by their side are more likely to find a safe permanent home, succeed in school and, half as likely to re-enter the foster care system.

Given the current situation, we anticipate that the need for trained CASAs will increase when life begins to return to the "new" normal. Additionally, with the uncertainty of hosting our annual fundraising events scheduled for this summer and fall, CASA of Polk County work remains more important than ever for our foster care children, especially in these unsure and rapidly changing times.
